

Technology Resolute was created nearly a decade ago by Aaron Cooper; starting as a small computer shop in Western Ohio and making only \$1,000 a month; Technology Resolute barely avoided going bankrupt during its first open quarter.

But that all changed when Jonathan Barkley—the creator of the COEUS OS, and Biosynch computer systems, joined the team. Barkley made changes to the company that allowed it to grow exponentially.

Barkley also insisted that Aaron allow him to sell his operating system in the shop, which Aaron reluctantly allowed him to do. And COEUS spread like wild fire, selling more than 20,000 copies in the first month alone. Soon thereafter, it became the standard operating system for all Technology Resolute computer systems. The United States Government even used the highly versatile operating system for their second generation UAVs, Tanks, and all other manner of technology.

Fast forward 9 years and TR Corp. has released dozens of new commercial and military products. Including the eight variations of the AGM's or Serum as it is called by the public; Intelligence and Strength, Telepathy and Pyrokinesis and Teleportation; all made possible by TR Corp.

We were lucky enough to get an interview with the men behind the curtain, Aaron Cooper & Jonathan Barkley.

ST: I have so many questions for the two of you, but we only have a small amount of time. In six months short of a decade, you guys have altered the technological, biological, and pretty much every other logical world to something nobody would have ever expected. Did you ever predict that Technology Resolute would make it this far?

AC: No I didn't, I mean I always had dreamed that I would maybe get my own chain of stores across the states—kind of like Best Buy, Circuit City, Wal-Mart—those kinds of things, but this right here is like a fantasy; Like I'm playing some kind of game. If I could go back in time and tell myself that in a decade's time, I would be selling an injection that could turn you into a

superhuman... I think I would—firstly say “who the hell are you old man?” and then be shocked.

ST: On the subject of time travel, you've already expanded humanities reach into space, with the first extraterrestrial colonies on both the moon and mars. Do you believe your next step is time travel?

AC: Time Travel is not possible... as far as I know. I mean I am just the corporate figurehead now a day. And let me tell you, 10 digits a paycheck is worth it.

JB: We don't plan on it. Mostly because of the major implications, it could have on our society. For example, let's say I want to shake hands with George S. Patton, so I go back to December 15th 1943 and catch Patton off duty, I get his attention and as he's walking over to me, he trips and breaks his ankle and is unable to perform his part in the Battle of the Bulge. and blah blah blah some how the Nazi's make their way over to the United States. That wouldn't be good at all.

ST: Have either of you ever personally used the AGM's?

AC: No, I have not, even though I make and sell them, I refuse to touch the stuff myself, and I like to stay one-hundred percent A-Grade Alpha-Human.

JB: I've tested out the intelligence one. It works pretty well, once you get past the primary side effects. However, I started to notice some kind of dependence to it. Like I couldn't think straight without it. It was almost like having a bad migraine that just wouldn't go away for weeks at a time. I've since stopped using it all together, and here we are ninety days later and I'm thinking clear.

ST: There have been many rumors lately surrounding Technology Resolute, and the AGM's. People are saying you violated human rights, and damaged used humans and animals alike. There are even stories from former employees of your company about animals being mutilated, people being
