List of Prohibited Behaviours:

- 1 - Do not wear red, red is a communist/revolutionary color.
- 2 - Do not fraternize with any enemy of the state.
- 3 - Do not under any circumstance urinate on any of our statues, walls, etc. Urinate in appropriate places.
- 4 - Do not travel anywhere until you have authorization.
- 5 - Do not print and/or distribute leaflets, or other pamphlets.
- 6 - Do not accept leaflet or pamphlets from any person. Ancillary: Report that person directly after the incident happens.
- 7 - Do not say anything which could be construed as a criticism of the government of West Djahar, or West Djahar itself. We are proud of both.
- 8 - Do not insult any of the Ministers
- 9 - Do not foment riots, or protests against the government. This is punishable by death.
- 10 - Do inform the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of where you intend to travel.
- 11 - Do inform the local police of the province that you are visiting in their province (Ajembukan, Djelam, Deltaville, and Amukahn.
- 12 - Do inform military authorities if you decide to travel outside of those cities.
- 13 - Do inform both the MOFA and military authorities if you intend to visit the Copper Mines (unless you go on a state-sponsored tourist trip.)
