ABSTRACT

The Chamber has proposed a Grade 9 reconstruction of the Outer Ring Boulevard.

Improving supposed sensual access to the four or more elegant bridges should help to ease tensions between higher and lower order citizens.

There is also a Wall.

A local Chapter of the Growers Association opposes the plan, insisting that mass-hallucinatory access to the River will disturb the water-based apparitions and mid-environed sprites.

The Chamber has noted the objection, setting aside four courses of an impending session to discuss the issues, which are many and varied.

INTRODUCTION

Recently, during normal hours, five junior members of the Chamber's General Assembly intercepted 15 HOC-driven slivers.

(One of two attendants from the 11 station was notably absent, taken with an imaginary illness of human-physical gut.)

The nodes were connected.

The pattern suggested late night, apparently synchronized emanations of packet from various local taverns.

While the intended targets functioned in disparate quarters, subsequent analyses by the Gormaticon revealed a high likelihood of activity concentration in the Piedmont, a pretty zone of cobbled sidewalks renowned for LOC-dominant incursions.

All fingers pointed to the possibility that the Piedmont packets might increase in extent and intensity over a certain period of time, which, per the distribution along the instructor's explorative curve, would likely promote distemper.

The supposed sustained nature of the generalized disturbance would likely bias the minds of the transmitters – and the stratum's group-mind, since these

HOCs were particularly well entrenched – towards rigidly antipathetic filters.

Notes from the Chamber's Records of Substance for the period provide illuminating detail on the brewing discontent.

For example, 14 of 17 notes:

The main issue is bi-i-bi-pronged.

It may be summarized by "human cultural anointment" and divided according to: (ia) the primary responsibilities of late night persons; (ib) the status of free play.

(ia) Primary responsibilities of late night persons

The Piedmont offers ample bazaar for snictual exchange.

The IRMs [Inner Ring Members] have questioned its Plan Δ credentials.

(ib) Status of free play

The potential distortions resulting from the implied deviations from proper symbolic play are staggering and, per the Gormaticon, within the realm of reasonable probability.

And 19 of 17:

GAMs with the appropriate leanings have reported, in association with Shah [an influential IRM], an apparently significant correspondence with the Chambric's presumed tendency towards overly isomeric behaviors.

And 12 of 21:

The pattern is similar to those observed during several recent studies, but it lacks the mirrored latching.

It is unclear whether the proposed adjustments are within the proper bounds.

The Journal has not appeared within the accustomed period of time.

Visions of the Platter are expected.

And so on.

ENTITIES

Entities move freely among systems, assuming whatever form is necessary to bridge the conceptual divide separating a design from the realm under review.

The incarnation of an Entity is always a lower order structure.

Entities incarnate as Chambers In the Hemyll design.

CHAMBERS

Chambers comprise 44 units: 37 GAMs (15 junior, 12 intermediate, 10 advanced) and 7 IRMs.

GAMs are purged at each Switching.

Their sets are placed in reserving booths, primed for application to subsequent Chambers.

IRMs are generally retained through the four quarters of a Ring (i.e., four successive incarnations of an Entity in Chamber form), after which their sets return to the Chambric and assume new responsibilities, often relating to the translation of third-dimensional concepts into forms suitable for absorption by the Conceptual Grid.

On completing these tasks, the IRM sets are applied to the first quarter of a new Ring, except for the most advanced, which are promoted to the next category within the string.

Occasionally, an overloaded IRM will abandon the Ring 'fore the snap of the fourth and repair to the Hemyll's More Erudite Saloon, a place of recuperative attendance where concepts hover between the conditions of unit and set.

In such instances, a temporary IRM is selected from the A-GAMs, and the Chamber operates at sub-capacity for the rest of the quarter.

Note that it is impossible for a GAM to properly cross over to the IR (and an IRM can never assume even temporary GAM-ship, by virtue of polarity), since the divisions operate along fundamentally incompatible incarnational streams.

However, as with the IRMs, the most advanced A-GAM sets can be promoted to the next category within the string.

Promoted sets are delivered to the next, non-Hemyll design in the CG hierarchy.

The location of the current Chamber (the first of the Ring) is a Town of the Northern Binrant which satisfies Plan Δ 's requirements for the first two third-dimensional skeins.

CHAMBRIC

Chambric are middle order structures.

They construct and exude the cloaks which the Entities assume in order to incarnate in the third dimension.

While Chambric perform their routine tasks in isolation, the larger, multiprobable strands are tackled by hexagonal Chambric clusters known as Charin.

Researchers of various bents have presumed an intimate correspondence between the Charin and family groupings on the planet, but a comprehensive study of the matter still awaits the nudge towards more highly paneled horse race.

During joint Chambric performances, carefully choreographed movements gently dislocate the Hemyll's tender equilibria.

The resulting energy waves' prime cephal excites the seven Nodes into simultaneous awakenings.

Fantastic ripples of hallucinatory potential are then slowly released from the Spheres, tiny globes of transparent material set atop the Nodes which

microreplicate the information-gathering processes then occurring in all realities under parallel, or topographical, review.

In the deceptively stuttering state of vibratory after-current which obtains in the latter stages of this Dance of the Spheres, the ripples are returned to the inner-static frequency.

To observe these happenings at the Screenings is a profound and humbling experience.

The gifts of the arisen Spheres are many, but perhaps the most significant is the opportunity for a single participant at the IRM or A-GAM level to "triple insert" the topographical references, enabling a crossover into any design in the hierarchy for as long as the rapidly decelerating DOS continues (for the sudden promotion of the relatively low-ranking IRM or A-GAM is a "core illusion" which quickly drains the system), which investigative action imbuing the entire Chamber (and, by extension, the entire then-active family tree, albeit with diminishing, self-evident returns as one ascends) with enhanced powers of hallucinatory insight.

THE OVERLORD

The Overlord is a higher order structure.

The Overlord directs the Hemyll hierarchy using Plans etched on the Platter.

The Plans combine to form the Hemyll's Common Goal.

THE HEMYLL

The Hemyll is the design.

It is known to comprise the booths, the MES, the Nodes, the Spheres, 900 Chambric, the Platter and the Overlord, though one suspects there's something else going on up there.

(Due to their transient nature, incarnated Entities (here, Chambers) are generally excluded from official counts.)

The Hemyll hierarchy is connected by an Occult Reptilian Cord running from the Overlord to the J-GAMs and their associates.

At each point of insertion, there are lashings of connubial slime.

CITIZENS

The Town is a reasonably clean, attractive and serviceable locale (a "rounded architecture with few processing factories", according to a recent pamphlet of some repute (though mean in production and original data)).

Its citizenry may be divided into three classes: LOCs, mid-stratum asexual citizens and HOCs.

Townfolk are no longer allocated using the system of socio-spiritual oric common in certain other zones of more uniform management, where a prolonged blurring of the means and methods of invasive sentiment has caused much confusion as to even the vaguest notions of proper spheres- and degrees-of-influence, at both the individual and degrees-of-massive levels.

In place of these hostile rhythms, the IRMs of the prior Ring devised a system of categorization which better nurtures the millimeter-thin layers of camouflaged opacity which, as it were, conceal, one from the other, the various sensitivities, and this has carried over.

The approach is highly unusual and often results in unreasonable designations.

For example, MSACs have been known to consume sugared nuts while standing in hotel lobbies.

Observing rump.

The recent history of the HOCs – particularly the HOC-driven "sucking" of the ORC – is quite interesting.

The Town was once composed almost entirely of MSACs (62%) and LOCs (32%).

While the period of widespread flights- and burrows-of-fancy had seen a slight rise in higher order representation (reaching 9% of total during Dank Bejemon), the temporal distortions invoked by the Global Disaster propelled these generally more sensitive souls back to the Abutting Hamlets.

The construction of five tall buildings in the Piedmont following the post-Disaster realignment of layers led to significant mutations within the vast proliferation of nine-level concepts supporting the Town's seminal-spiritual grids, however, and the generally higher order Abutting Hamletpersons were drawn in droves to the sights, sounds and obfuscations of the reformed urban canyon, as raised buzzers to lick-honeyed fluids.

(It was at this point that the River was temporarily diverted to a sequence running closer to the Building, since the Chamber required more intimate associations to cope with the spike in demand for nine-level hallucinations.

(The flooded ORB would emerge as swamp following the River's readmission.)

The mass infusion of HOCs and commensurate constructs was observed by the Charin during the Reviews.

The revised set of probable topographies was submitted to the Overlord for consideration as part of the proposed multi-Chambric crossovers (i.e., Plan 4Δ).

With its unusually low cross-favor quotients, the Town was quickly approved as first and second third-dimensional skein, and preparations were soon underway to transmit the first incarnation of a new Entity at the next Switching.

Now, particularly in this time of extensive J-GAM infiltration, the citizens are active in many ways, attending to diverse tasks of instigation, continuance and completion, with gross motions of thinking, feeling and willing deflating during the nighttime periods, when the bodies rest in the chambers.

It is, ironically, the very resting which primes the cells for reintegration, for in the tenuous fibrils 'twixt sleep-state and wake, the flaccid bodies are "pumped up" with hallucinogenic materials, and this has been the case for several aeons, even during the planet's very early developmental stages, prior to the arrival of the first Chamber and during the time-signed passage of strange walking things observed from atop the crag.

For the chambers of sleep are designed and aligned to attract the centralized transmissions of Ordered sentiment from the five-point bases of the Other Side, even in treacherous conditions which preclude swimming.

HOCs attract packets of negative undulation (and these may include such impulses as those towards the arts, lookings-into-the-eyes, etc.), and vice-versa (the MSACs do not concern us).

The proposed hallucination would shoot up a nighttime protectorate, or Wall, to serve as a barrier to such dispatch during the periods of highest susceptibility.

It is the determined grasping of Shah that controlling attacks on the deflated bodies would greatly mitigate OS influence and restore the generally peaceful relations of a free-flowing hierarchy.

In conclusion, HOCs and LOCs possess families, chambers, casements and casements of pet.

Each is worked alone and in combination with one or more of the others.

THE GROWERS ASSOCIATION

The GA was devised by six prominent Southern Binrant groupings.

With an average daytime temperature well outside the range ordained by the then-covert Order as expedient for inflated relations, the Southern cupping struck the rebel (at the time) units as a more than fitting origin and base-of-operations for an entity whose primary directing focus would be the sustained, ruthless excavation of self-aggrandizing disregard for non-physical life-systems (particularly water-based).

An excerpt from the minutes of the Second Meeting of Instance describes the GA's philosophy in somewhat more poetic terms.

All rise.

And remember it so.

And keep it so.

And on.

[The Manat surveys the room.

[Her curved and dexterous mate sprawls and contorts on the next-throne-but-one [for the middle is always reserved in respectful deference].]

Now sit.

[There is silence, with the occasional packet.

[Eventually, She rises, and the creature is pure devotion.]

I, the Manat – I, Manatison – hereby convene this most illustrious gathering, this Second Meeting of Instance of the Growers Association of the Southern Binrant.

[Sustained and sonorous packet from all corners, particularly the top level of the east-facing balconies and the middle row of the Director's Royal Lounge.

[The Manat surveys the room.]

Questions.

[The Manat is asked to briefly describe the GA's aims and goodliness.

[She laughs deeply and there is thunderous, circular packet, uniform in extension.

[One feels as if one were surfing tidal waves of consistency and high regard.]

The short answer then, sir?

[The packet is deafening.

[One truly feels as if individual identities have been collectively and simultaneously subsumed under the wide-brimmed bonnet of benevolent authority set atop the blazing dome of some Higher Mistress or Lord.

[The charming interrogator is clearly overwhelmed.

[His body starts to rattle.

[He might collapse to the lower surface.

[And yet, he manages to signify, with a limp-wristed wave of hands spread nigh two feet apart, that any answer the Manat cared to provide would be more than propitious, given the prodigious context.]

Then listen.

[Packet which excites and astounds.]

Nod to the Hemyll,

Wink to the sly.

A lighthearted musing:

"You gave us the lie!"

[There is an urge to set down the tablet.

[I will now enter this most joyous fracas with arms aloft and eyeball ablaze.

[My pardon to you, dear reader or auditor, mind-seer or tradesperson, as I relinquish my role for a time and become this most ancient creature once more.

[Ah, Manatitan!

[I am indeed this most ancient creature!]

In two significant ways, the Chamber and the GA assume joint familial containership:

(i) both have been charged, by "higher powers of this realm and others", to implement bespoke-tailored fittings for every common tendency towards the manigued coupling of Object and Idea;

(ii) the fountains of panic which somewhat explode from the hinterlanded oric of the GAMs during the irregular tuitions may be artfully woven into fine-sieved nettings which mesh more than nicely with the GA's pattern of near-chronic incompetence in failing to establish suitable lodgings for the demonstration sessions.

The 94th Reading Room was granted Meeting Group status during the most arduous moment of the Global Disaster.

During its unusually lengthy mid-novitiate of MG-ship, this quaint society, headquartered in a somewhat quiet Town, grew its membership, in typically entrepreneurial fashion, from the seven Founders to over 19 persons (including the Founders).

The Group was approved to Chapter status following the necessarily apparently-untimely physical deaths and bodily destructions of two younger members.

Unfortunately, the Chapter's Prime Founder, a short man with few intimate associates, physically expired prior to the First Visit.

While preparations had been underway for some time, and the Town had been sprinkled with an index of ample Southern mode, the removal of Prime to Other Parts was somewhat inconvenient, to say the least.

It was determined by the remaining six, in the usual manner of ritualized accoutrement accompanied by imploring genuflections of "betwixt-I-Thou-ness", that the physically dead man's partner (a Founder) would occupy his ("dead" man's) position, and that their offspring unit (12) would be promoted from the rank of junior member to Post-Founding Founder status.

All was in place just prior to the Visit, all was found to be to the Manat's and Director's likings, and the Chapter flourished (while pursuing an occult agenda).

CONSTRUCTS

The Chamber selected a Grade 9 procedure for the braids of spermatic tendrils which extend from its products (core and derived) and their associates.

Thus, the ORB (core), Wall (derived) and citizenry (associates) would all assist in the ensnarement of OS influence.

Grade 9 cores are generally surprisingly inexpensive to manufacture, particularly in Buildings associated with liquid flowings of at least 50 meters of width, 60 furlongs of length and no more than 17 micromimeses of current.

The River handily meets the 9's recommendations.

The River is spanned by four or more elegant bridges in the suspension style, connecting the West Bank with the Adroit Runt.

The Order constructed the bridges soon after the readmission, since the River had broadened by 14 micromimesetic inches during its diversion, making it humanly uncrossable by swimming by all but the most hardy adventurers and escapees (not to mention the swamp).

And the situation would deteriorate significantly during phanariotic storms, when even the most brazen might fail to extend to the Runt with ease, and

thence to the meat, where they had so often attended even the most fleeting whiff of transposed demonstration.

Six of the four or more are used by the Chamber to simultaneously channel the directives of the Chambric, transmit status reports to the Charin and organize the GAMs into their ROS groupings through pure-telepathic suggestions delivered during the irregular tuitions.

Not surprisingly, the bridge construct has been known to offer fecund inspiration to painters of landscapes in the more literal styles, which category now comprises some 90% of the HOCs and LOCs.

Indeed, it was the focused concentration of the longer-sighted of such which originally brought the bridgework to the attention of the Charin, since the spasmodic tugs associated with the tightening of the nines which usually follows the "extension of invisible tuber from forehead of observer to entire outline and supposed inner stuffness of observed" often drive the creation of legacy structures in planetary topographies, at least when viewed from a Screening perspective.

Topographical forms greatly aid the Charin in detecting the local energy whorls which will, in mass-hallucinated forms, sustain a subsequent Entity's focus in the same locale.

The construct of a suave and attractive bartender is the current point of inspiration.

While the influence of the Order has interfered with the precise detection of the whorls, one suspects the Piedmont tavern construct has an important part to play.

CROSS-FITMENT

The various public assistance campaigns erupted into the designated realities with relatively little fanfare one pepper-crisp evening in winter.

A delicately mediocre touche of snow dusted the faux-irregular stonement of the Piedmont's gritty underbellied realm, and the scratching prismatic sparkled like sun-baked River lappings in the light-sheets and -duvets cast by pocket torches and faux-gasoline streetlamps, the former finger-handled by certain persons conducting themselves in manners of barely concealed adventure.

And such category of "bearers of manhandled torchieres" to comprise most of the more perspicacious of the evening's promenaders, those whose intermittent inklings of the Other occasioned walking routes right to the very edge of the swamp, and the transport of Light to opportune mind-maps of the seminal pipes and tubes.

And perhaps, even, to apprise of their subtle operation, for it is said the nines wind with near nary a hint.

There was much activity in the Building that night.

The winds were whipping, the mm were up and the Sensual Machine would be set at last *in tandem operand* with the Gormaticon, divulging the campaign

efforts at the multiple viewpoints aforesaid.

And the door to the Inner Sanctum had been left temptingly ajar, with the interwoven strands of the SensiGorm packets winding as the probing helices...

And it is *this* image and probability-of-occurrence which the Chamber would awaken by the third assigned course of the impending session, wine, raisins and all.

And it is *this* productive action of the SensiGorm – fed by high-mm waters and literally *screamed* across all continua under review – which the infiltrating J-GAMs even now drip, as with alchemical pipette, into the consumption materials of the principal strata, and into the pets of such, and the concepts of such, and the little offspring of such, and so on.

And it is the simultaneous realization of *this* confluence which the principal strata must nearthwort obtain, albeit with widely varying, presumed-subjective suppositions.

The Chamber opted for an ambitious two-season schedule, with multiple crossovers at each privy layer.

This has required – and indeed will continue to require, until the very early morning of the impending session, when all must play as it will – mass-coordinated observations at the multiconceptual level, no small feat given the tremendous variations between the Chambric's various intersections.

For to convince the principal strata of even the *possibility* of convergence through gross demonstration at the physical level will demand sudden, wholly unexpected (though, perhaps, strangely familiar, given the lengthy spell of dripping indoctrination, and this is perhaps advantageous) bursts of such maddening oscillation; and these near-chthonic motions to accede *almost immediately* to the guidance of some relatively impotent function of time and space, such to be derived through the SensiGorm's manifold "retrofitting" of those ethereal dimensions' beacons; and all this that They might be implored to accept into Their systems, for even a brief planetary moment, these rather base and unholy operations....

Well, suffice to say, the MES has never enjoyed such mirth.

Now, as "hither hinted with a prior poking out", the campaigns take full advantage of the diverse chameleonic abilities of the J-GAMs, who, guided by the irregular bridge-telepathic intrusions, have spent quite some time infiltrating the lives and lifestyles of the HOCs and LOCs.

Inexpensive?

Hardly.

With each investigator requiring almost constant supervision by a mentoring IRM, as well as sufficient SSG-derived energy to cross-fit the citizens' perceptions according to the agreed patterns of assistance, the spiralingly distasteful crusade – outlined on tablets by Shah and squeezed through by coordinated pumpings of the joint apparatus' five bellow chamber "wobblies" –

has proven remarkably immoderate of coin.

Indeed, one wonders whether the Chapter's most assured counter at the impending session might not invite to the point of intuition the apparent hypocrisy of the Overlord's defiance of the standard-economic Order and nigh-confirmed deviation from the Primary Operative's insistence on the flow of generally free mentation.

A recourse of inveigling salve, it would appear, particularly given the misfortunate repercussions of the hush-hushed affair involving that scandalously nubile swimmer, the smooth-scaled maiden who spent many a night in the Other's less-than-plush tabernacles, hurling attack of word and spit, and resolving ever deeper degree of emotional eye.

The Legend of Cross-Fitment is quite interesting.

Towards the end of the Piedmont renewal, preparations were well under way for the Fourth Stage Assessment, an important review of the prior Entity's accomplishments to the so-designated juncture in the Ring.

The Building's location at the time – a rocky promontory at the Town's northern tip – required an ill-fitting bucket-on-head system of extension to channel the SM its daily waters.

The J- and I-GAMs were happy to carry out the work, however, particularly given the idyllic views occasioned by understated ambles to the edge of that particular gestalt.

However, these almost human operations made for occasional slippages in the fidelities of the then-dominant hallucinations.

As a result, several impressionable J-GAMs found themselves tuning their systems, at first involuntarily, to certain fast-expanding matters.

There was an appeal for assistance.

The Charin's directive was presented in neatly scrawled script on the next free page of the perfumed Journal:

23 of the non-standard are yours.
With adequate mm in the valley-build.

So was born the public assistance technique of cross-fitment, and it is the prime doctor in the Chamber's present campaigns, carefully orchestrating an integrated, crossover-type fermentation, with disseminations per everyday interactions between infiltrating members and citizens of the principal strata.

Three non-standards remain.

It is said they rest deep in the Building's tomb, gathering for a wild ejection towards the end of the second course (palate cleanser).
